I agree to abide by these standards of conduct as a student of Trinity Christian Academy:

- 1. I will arrive on time and be seated in my assigned desk by 7:55 a.m.
- 2. I will have my homework ready to be checked at the beginning of the school day.
- 3. I will have all assigned work completed when it is due. If not, I realize that the result will be a grade of "zero" for that assignment. I understand that on the third such incident, a teacher-parent conference will be conducted, and that any further failures to have assigned work will result in serious disciplinary action.
- 4. I will have all required materials for each class, and will have no other objects or materials on my desk.
- 5. I will not talk without the teacher's permission, will avoid conduct that would distract other students, and will be orderly and respectful at all times.
- 6. I will get a drink of water, use the restroom, and get the needed classroom materials from my locker during teacher announced breaks. I understand that I will not be permitted to leave the classroom during the class period except in emergency situations.
- 7. I will be attentive and will do my seatwork along with the instructor and/or the student in the video classroom.
- 8. I will avoid sleeping during class, and avoid disruptive noises or behavior of any kind.
- 9. I will comply with the school's Dress Code, realizing that violations will result in my being sent home, if necessary, until compliance is met.
- When my class is finished, I will remain seated, and will remain quiet until the teacher 10. announces the end of that class period.
- 11. I will refrain from lying; cheating; stealing; sexual immorality; use of tobacco; use of alcoholic beverages; and use of illegal substances. I will refrain from fighting, engaging in "horseplay", or rough play, or running or speaking loudly in the halls between classes.
- 12. I will refrain from inappropriate displays of affection when interacting with persons.
- I will protect and take care of the school's property, and will respect the property of 13. others.
- 14. I will apply myself to the studies, and will endeavor to develop the full powers of my mind.
- I will abide by the instructions given by the school's leadership, and any rules or 15. regulations that may be adopted by the school's administration.
